The Agribusiness Academy is designed so that students can pursue their own interests through unique opportunities not already offered through regular course offerings. To be an academy completer the baseline requirements include completing the courses listed below, 1 job shadow experience, and 1 internship. Other requirements such as Lunch & Learns, Off-Site Learning Experiences, and Work Based Learning projects vary by grade level and are conducted mainly during academy classes.

Students participate in **team building activities, interdisciplinary projects, carefully designed field trips, project-based learning, and work-based learning experiences.**

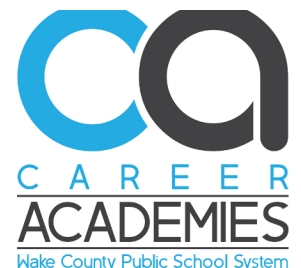
Work-based learning experiences include (but not limited to) **job shadowing, business tours, and completing a minimum of 135-hour internship.**
